

How the STEER Program works:

1. STEER, Inc. recruits donors – businessmen, churches and individuals – to make a financial investment.
2. STEER, Inc. places the investment with a farmer or rancher by providing funds to purchase livestock or seed of choice as well as covering the insurance and depreciation of the investment.
3. The farmer or rancher provides the labor, feed and care for livestock or the labor, use of land and machinery for seeding and harvesting crops.
4. At the time of harvest or market, the farmer or rancher makes a sale from the cattle or crops and STEER, Inc. donates the majority of profit to FCA.
